

Evaluation Report on DLG-funded Other Programmes (Gifted Education) 2016 – 17

Title:	Speech Festival
Objectives	To enhance students' knowledge and interest in English and Speech arts
Deliverables	Joining the Speech Festival in Choral Speaking Joining public speaking team competition
Target	5A, 5B, 4C, 4D Individuals selected by teachers
Selection mechanism	8 teams of three were invited to join public speaking team competition' 5A, 5B, 4C, 4D were selected to join Choral Speaking
Duration and venue	1/10 – 20/12
Evaluation	The results were remarkable. Three classes got the champion in Choral Speaking and of the 7 senior public speaking teams, three got champions, 2 got second place and two got third place. All teams got into the top three.
Expenditure	\$ 8,000.00

Title:	From Page to Stage
Objectives	To arouse students' in drama performance.
Deliverables	Watch the drama Frankenstein by AFTEC
Target	Students interested in drama
Selection mechanism	10 students were selected.
Duration and venue	March, Sai Wan Ho Civic Centre
Evaluation	Students were absorbed in the story and stage presentation.
Expenditure	\$3,000.00

Title:	HKUST Dual Programme (HKUST The Center for the Development of the Gifted & Talented) and other tertiary institutions e.g. CUHK Program for the Gifted & Talented & organisations related to gifted education in Hong Kong
Objectives	To subsidise programmes for the accelerated learning and independent learning of high-achievers and/or potentially gifted students especially at science and mathematics.
Deliverables	Pre-stage courses in Mathematics & Physics & Level 1 in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry & Life Science
Target	18 F.3-F.4 students have attended HKUST Dual Programme (Level 1: Chemistry; Life Science, Physics & Maths and Pre-stage Maths & Physics). Their programme fees were subsidized by DLG & ECA. Some F.3 students who attended Maths & Physics in Pre-stage level found them difficult to handle the courses and their time requirement. Two students obtained A in Pre-stage Physics and one got A+ in Pre-stage Maths. Six obtained Grade B which allowed them to be eligible to be promoted to a higher level in HKUST Dual Programme. Among 18 participants, five F.4 of them obtained DLG subsidies and had participated in Pre-Stage and Level 1 courses.
Selection mechanism	Students for HKUST programmes were nominated by Science, Mathematics & Class teachers based on <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -their potential and ability in respective fields; and -their motivation and self-initiation
Duration and venue	About 17 lessons in 6 months A 3-hour lesson weekly held on Saturdays in the HKUST
Evaluation	Among five F.4 participants who obtained DLG subsidies, two of them had received a Grade B which made them eligible to be promoted to a higher level. One had got satisfactory result and two did not perform satisfactorily.
