Title:	HKUST Dual Programme

Duration and venue	About 17 lessons in From late November 2017- April 2018 and each 3-hour lesson weekly held on Saturdays in the HKUST
Evaluation	Among fifteen F.4-5 participants who obtained DLG subsidies, seven of them received Grade A and two obtained Grade B which made them all eligible to be promoted to a higher level.
