Title:	HKUST Dual Programme
Objectives	To subsidise programmes for the accelerated learning and independent learning of high-achievers and/or potentially gifted students especially at science and mathematics.
Deliverables	Level 1 in Mathematics & Chemistry; Level 2 in Physics, Mathematics, Life Science and Engineering;
Target	Nine F.4-5 students have been accepted into HKUST Dual Programme. Among them, five were in Level 1: Chemistry & Maths and four of them have been further accepted into 2019 Dual Programme Level 2 (Maths, Physics, Life Science & Engineering).
Selection mechanism	F.4-5 Students for HKUST programmes were nominated by Science, Mathematics & Class teachers based on -their potential and ability in respective fields; and -their motivation and self-initiation
Duration and venue	For Level 1, about 17 lessons in from late November 2018- April 2019 and for Level 2, from late October 2018 to April 2019 and each 3-hour lesson weekly held on Saturdays in the HKUST
Evaluation	All nine F.4-5 participants who obtained DLG subsidies performed satisfactorily in their courses, particularly the four Level 2 participants with three of them obtained Grade A- or above.
